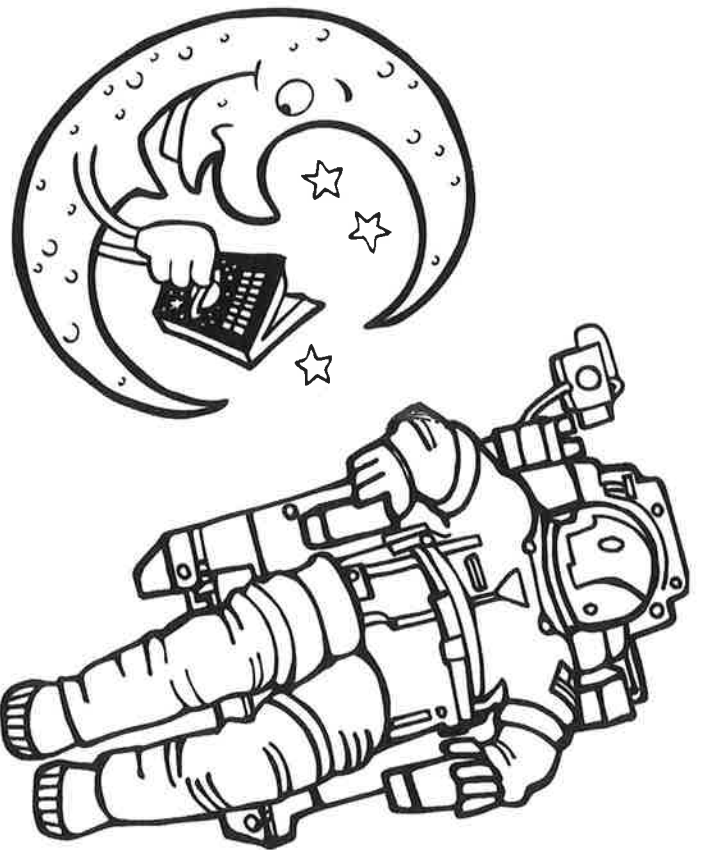

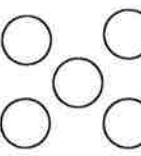

Fill in the bubbles and collect prizes after every five days of reading.

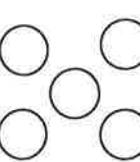

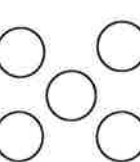

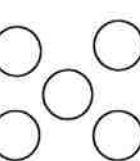

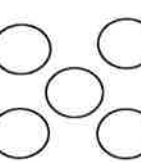

Rules and Opportunities 2019

READING LOG (BUBBLE SHEET) - Pick up a Reading Log or download and print it at home, color in bubbles for each day you have read. It counts the same if you are reading or someone reads to you. You can read LIBRARY books/ebooks/magazines/audiobooks, OR books/ebooks/magazines/audiobooks from anywhere else. I would say a reading day is a day you have read 20 minutes or more. You decide, based on YOUR child's ability to sit still and reading skill, if this is a good benchmark at YOUR house. The last day to turn in reading logs is July 31st.

CHECK OUT LIBRARY BOOKS - Put your child's name and phone number on the back of your checkout slip and put it in the bin at the checkout desk. There will be a drawing each Wednesday at the 2pm program. All slips turned in by noon will be eligible. The winner gets a bag of candy (a grab bag of prizes may be substituted if food concerns are present - ask).

COUPON GAME - There is a different question to be answered in the children's room each week. If you participate, whether your answer is right or wrong, you will be entered into a drawing for candy (a grab bag of prizes may be substituted if food concerns are present - ask). There will be a drawing on Wednesday at each 2pm program.

READING CHALLENGE - Complete the 15 activities on the sheet (you will get this when you sign up at the library or download and print at home). Fill in the titles you read on the back of the paper, put your name and phone number on the paper, have an adult initial/sign your paper, AND hand it in at the library. You will get to choose 1 paperback book.

SPACE CHALLENGE - Complete this paper alone or as a family (you will get this when you sign up at the library or download and print at home). Do 8 of the activities on the sheet. You must mark the activities you did, put your name and phone number on the paper, have an adult initial/sign your paper, AND hand it in at the library. You will get to choose 1 paperback book.

SPACE CHALLENGE PHOTOS/VIDEO - Send us a photo OR video of you doing one or all of the Space Challenge activities. Photos are to be used on our facebook page. You must send us the picture/video in order to have completed this activity. Photos can be emailed to [Carnegie@seolibraries.org](mailto:Carnegie@seolibraries.org) or uploaded to the Carnegie Public Library Facebook page. Feel free to send multiple photos or videos. You will get 1 additional paperback book this summer.

July 31st - This is the last day to turn in papers for rewards unless you make arrangements with Miss Kim in advance. Extensions are granted if you will be out of town that day. Record keeping stops on July 31st.
