READING LOG (BUBBLE SHEET) - Curbside pickup a Reading Log or download and print it at home, color in bubbles for each day you have read. This is independent reading or being read to. You can read or listen to books/magazines however you can get them (LIBRARY or HOME). A reading day is a day you have read 20 minutes or more. Get your prizes curbside as you earn them or at the end. The last day to turn in reading logs is July 29th.

FAMILY SCAVENGER HUNTS- There are 8 scavenger hunts to do this summer. Complete your quests and hand them in at the library with your name and phone number on them. You will get a small prize for each child/student who participated. One copy of each hunt will be entered into a drawing for a "Movie Night" gift basket

COUPON GAME - There are 8 questions to be answered this summer. All the questions will be given on a single sheet of paper. Answer each question.
